
- **All documents concerning your partnership/collaboration/relationship with Housing Rights Committee of San Francisco ("HRCSF") for the last four years**

I ask for a determination on this request within 10 days of your receipt of it, and an even prompter reply if you can make a determination without having to review the records in question. If you determine that any or all of the information qualifies for an exemption from disclosure, I ask that you note whether the exemption is discretionary, and if so whether it is necessary in this case to exercise your discretion to withhold the information. If you determine that some but not all of the information is exempt from disclosure and you intend to withhold it, I ask that you redact the exempt portion and make the rest available as requested.

In any event, please provide a signed notification citing the legal authorities on which you rely if you determine that any or all of the information is exempt and will not be disclosed.

If I can provide any clarification that will help expedite this request please contact me. Please notify me of any costs associated with this request.
